SETTING UP THE WORKSTATION

STEP 1: Connect external devices, power and network.

1. Connect a monitor, USB keyboard, USB mouse and network cable.

2. Connect the workstation to an appropriate power source. It is recommended to use a UPS system.

* 750VA or higher is recommended.

3. Power up the workstation by pressing the power button on the front of the workstation. (F1 on the diagram on page 2) if it did not turn on automatically.

* Connecting the power cable to the live power source may turn on the workstation automatically.



STEP 2: Configure date and time

- 1. Double-click on the date and time icon on the desktop.
 - Change time <u>z</u>one...
- (default is UTC-08:00 Pacific Time).



2. Change time zone if it is not correct

Press OK after selecting the correct time zone.

Click "Change date and time..." to update the date and time if they are not correct.

* Verify the time zone before updating the date and time. Time may show 2 or 3 hours off due to incorrect time zone.
